NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY

The Southern Huntingdon County School District offers vocational programs in business education, vocational agriculture, consumer homemaking, and other programs offered at the Huntingdon County Career and Technology Center. Admission to the vocational programs offered at the Southern Huntingdon County High School/Middle School are open to all students. Admission to the vocational programs at the Huntingdon County Career and Technology Center are based on the Southern Huntingdon County School District policy as approved by the Southern Huntingdon County School Board.

It is the policy of the Southern Huntingdon County School District not to discriminate against any person, in any action or decision regarding admissions, programs, activities, or employment policies, on the age, sex, race, religion, place of origin, color, or by reason of any personal, physical, or mental handicap.

It is the policy of the Southern Huntingdon County School District to observe, conform with, and abide by the provisions of the following:

1. Equal Rights and Opportunities Act;
2. Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964;
3. Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, and the Education of the Handicapped Children Act of 1975 (P.L. 94-142);
4. Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972; and
5. The Age Discrimination Act of 1975.
